Details of the battery are as follows:

Name of product: Lithium Metal Cell (non-rechargeable)

Chemical System: LiMnO2 Nominal Battery Voltage: 3V Model: CR-2450 or CR-2032

Lithium Content: Contains <= 0.16g Lithium per data logger

The above-mentioned batteries are categorized under UN3091 (Lithium metal batteries contained in equipment) and comply with the requirements of the 66th Edition (2025) of the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) Packing Instruction 970 Section II.

As such, a Dangerous goods declaration is not required. The words "Lithium metal batteries in compliance with Section II of PI 970" should be included in any AWB. The lithium battery mark is not required on packages as the above data loggers are powered by only button (coin) cells. This is regardless of the quantity of data loggers in a particular package or the number of packages in a consignment.

This declaration is effective from 1st January 2025 to 31st December 2025, subject to the current regulations remaining in force for that period.
